CORONAVIRUS (COVID 19) UPDATES

While in our custody and care, your health and safety is our primary mission. We continue prioritizing your safety with some changes and updates in operations.

Please keep in mind, this is a very fluid situation and the direction and information we are receiving is changing daily, and in some cases hourly.

At this time, there are no suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our jails.

VISITING

As part of Sheriff's Office COVID-19 prevention efforts, normal visiting will be suspended until further notice. Legal visits will continue. We value visitation, but at this time the Sheriff's Office must make difficult decisions in order to protect the health and wellness of all who live in, work in, and visit our jails.

FIVE KEYS CHARTER SCHOOL

All academic charter school programs are suspended until further notice. Teachers will provide students with enough independent study work to engage students.

PROGRAMS and SERVICES

All programs and services provided by community members and organizations are suspended until further notice. The Sheriff's Office values the time and talents that so many of our community members share with people for tours, events, and other positive activities. At this time, we are canceling any events prohibited by guidelines established by the City and County Health Officer that compromise safe social distancing.

We will continue to ensure clean and healthy living conditions and the continuation of access to medical, dental, and mental health services for you. If you are feeling ill or exhibiting signs and symptoms of coronavirus, please contact a staff member immediately.
